Dear Doctor Evans:-

I have received word through Mr. Schaefer's office that a crew consisting of C. H. Johnson, Everett Clough, and Rudy F. Williams are to clean a scale tank in Baltimore on January 12, 13, and possibly the 14th. It is our feeling that the hazards of this work while potentially great are being handled quite well but, as you know, we have made it a point to follow these men as carefully as possible. I have considered it advisable to take samples on them from time to time in close relation to their actual work. Therefore I suggest the advisability of obtaining spot samples of the urine of these men promptly after their return from this job. If you would be good enough to have them in and have these samples obtained for us, I should appreciate it. Of course we will not include these analyses among the charges made on men employed in the lead Ethyl area.
