Our friend's son, [Ex. 6 Personal Privacy (PP)] (age 31), recently died while using a Methylene Chloride based paint stripper. He was a physically fit young man, college graduate, and co-owner of a successful business.

He was not one to ignore labels or safely precautions. He was wearing a respirator and heavy gloves.

It is my understanding that the US Military has phased out the use of this toxic chemical. I am married to a Vietnam Combat Veteran. While I applaud the protection of our military, why is this same protection not afforded to the general public?

I will share all this information with family and friends so that they too can learn about this toxic product.

Please help me understand why the EPA has indefinitely postponed its ban on Methylene Chloride. (EPA-HQ-OPPT-2016-0231-0001)?
