TO THE GOVERNMENT ACTUARY, ON BEHALF OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT OF WESTERN AUSTRALIA.

I, Hammerby Langeskjold, of the Australian Blue Asbestos Limited, do hereby declare that you will issue a policy indemnifying me against all claims under the Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1938, the Employers' Liability Act, 1891, and at Common Law for compensation to employees and workers engaged in my business of mining.

The Liability under the Policy for any claim arising otherwise than under the Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1938, or the Employers' Liability Act, 1891, is limited to the sum of £5,000 in respect of any one disaster, and to the sum of £1,000 for each individual insured, inclusive of costs and expenses incurred in connection therewith.

The policy will be accepted and held subject to the conditions to be expressed therein with the proviso that the conditions under the Mines Regulation Act, 1906, relating to the inspection and examination of persons liable to be affected with tuberculosis, must be observed by the employer, and the certificates therein referred to produced to the Government Actuary, or his Agent, if and when required.

The Premium above stated has been calculated upon the amount expected to be paid as wages and salaries by the employer and his Sub-Contractors during the term of the said Policy, and is subject to rebate or increase in order to meet any difference arising from variation between the amount estimated to be paid as wages and salaries during the period and the actual amount so paid. I undertake to keep a correct account of all wages and salaries paid to my employees and workers in a proper and regular Wages Book, and to require my Sub-Contractors to keep similar Wages Books, and on request supply the Government Actuary with a correct account of all such wages and salaries, and submit such Wages Books to the inspection of the Government Actuary whenever required, either for the purpose of verifying the correctness of a claim or ascertaining the proper amount of Premium.

DECLARATION.

I hereby declare and warrant that the answers of statements given above are true and correct in every respect, and that I have not concealed any important circumstances that ought to be communicated to the State Government. And I hereby agree on behalf of Australian Blue Asbestos Limited that this proposal and declaration shall be the basis of contract for effecting the above-mentioned Indemnity, and to issue a policy as now applied for.
