Dear Mr. Humanick:

Pursuant to our complaint investigation regarding asbestos, we are requesting access to medical records for each of the employees on the attached list.

Under 29 CFR 1910.1001(j)(6)(ii), the following records are to be reviewed: *(122 employees)*

- (a) All X-rays taken since July 7, 1972.
- (b) The results of and the actual tracings of all pulmonary function tests taken since July 7, 1972.
- (c) The medical histories elicited as part of 29 CFR 1910.1001(j).
- (d) Any diagnosis or evaluation sheets or correspondence relating to the above medical records.

Dr. David Logan, a consultant physician in OSHA's National Office, and Compliance Officer Gary Mosher will be personally reviewing these records. We would also like to confer with your medical staff at that time. We propose the week of January 1, 1980 for this review.
