The vinyl chloride (monomer) and polyvinyl chloride (polymer) industry is funding an epidemiological study of the industry to be carried out by the thoroughly competent firm of Tabershaw and Cooper. The study will be carried out without inspection of medical records or contact with the labor force. They will microfilm the personnel summary card of those employees who have had some exposure to vinyl chloride monomer vapors. This will involve only our Painesville and Monochem plants. Both Chemical and Borden management are familiar with the program planned and are supporting it. It is important that Dr. McCleary have a telegram in MCA's office by Friday, April 16, giving Uniroyal approval. Unless you see reason why Painesville and Monochem should not make personnel records available for this study, I will have Dr. McCleary give the approval.
