Debbie, many thanks for the COA pre-advice. Have given the details to Stewart Dakin (production manager of Ross Catherall).

His comments are -

- 1/ The details are incomplete - there is no mention of Zinc analysis, which is extremely important to him -
- 2/ Unless we can assure him that the Zinc analysis has been done AND the analysis reading is < 35 ppm, this lot is not acceptable
- 3/ We both assume that the profs advice is a pre-advice, not intended to be the one and only COA. He needs a formal COA on Du Pont letterhead signed by a competent authorised signatory (because of his critical end use, certification is crucially important.
- 4/ All of the foregoing is accepted in writing by Phil Pombier, and adherence is essential.

- SD - a/ can you please confirm that Bin 3B has been analysed for Zinc, AND the reading is < 35 ppm
- b/ If you are able to, please advise, AND set this shipment rolling to the port for shipment
 - c/ Please confirm that formal COA is/has been prepared (including the Zinc AND specifying the pallet nos from Bin 3P) and is being sent by air-letter as specified in the original order.

Plse advise progress urgent - Ross Catherall needed this material before Christmas, which now seems unlikely ...
