OSHA PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS - ASBESTOS

This is to confirm our discussion recently relative to your letter of December 7, 1972 regarding the hazards associated with the pulmonary function test.

As I advised you, our medical authorities assured me that there is no hazard involved in the type of test prescribed, since it is basically a passive one and does not require any undue exertion. Any difficulties our employees may have had probably is due to a general emotional reaction to taking the physical.

Attached is a copy of literature describing the type of unit involved.

We would like to get a copy of each physical with the X-ray interpretation and pulmonary test results from the Erie Plant to review results of the examinations. Would you arrange for this?
