Dear Doctor:

Your letter March 21: There has been the usual corresponding back and forwards on the personnel of the reviewing committee, but it looks now as though Messrs. Hellmuth (Chairman), Banash and past President Scott, will be announced soon. The latest resignation has come from Mr. Pettibone this morning.

Meantime I have gone through all of the formalities of notifying Mr. Hoyt, of the American Foundrymen's Association, of our committee resolution and I am advised by Mr. Hoyt that the six foundry associations will appoint representatives to be formed into a Steering Committee, and then a committee of three will prepare reasonably soon their comments on the Technical Committee's report. Mr. Hoyt told me also that the sand people will not be represented on this committee "because they have had their day in court." Mr. Hoyt will look after the interests of the foundry people and focus attention on their promises to the Council, and I shall make sure that our reviewing committee are kept informed of progress and receive the comments as they come in. I shall, of course, keep you closely informed on events as they transpire.
