Dear Dr. Kehoe:

The press of activities in getting our Aerometric Survey started next Monday has prevented my replying to your letter of July 15 as promptly as I would wish. However, I understand from Dr. Rogers here that he has been in contact frequently with Mr. Cholak and everything is proceeding as rapidly as possible.

We have no objection to the short form of agreement substantially as submitted but would like to suggest a couple of changes or additions as follows:

To fit in with our other programs here, we would prefer, if it can be arranged at your end, to have you bill us monthly, the Foundation being committed to pay up to \$30,500 and any billings beyond that figure to be by mutual agreement.

The other point may not have to be spelled out in the contract but we hope it will be possible to arrange to airmail analytical results two or three times weekly, as soon as samples start coming in. I assume we will be shipping samples three times a week during the four-months' period, or perhaps even a little more frequently. We feel it is important as we go along here from day-to-day to have as full and complete information on our survey as we go along. All of our other projects are being handled on this basis. We will have a competent statistical organization collating our data daily. I realize, of course, that there must necessarily be a few days' lag in your case, but I do hope that this can be kept to a reasonable minimum.

If either or both of these suggestions meet with your approval, we are prepared to sign and proceed with you forthwith.

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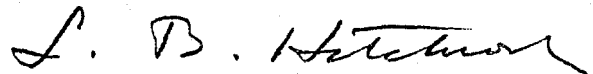
