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Dear Bob:

Confirming our today's conversation, I understand you are both agreeable and anxious to send Dr. Vorwald serial x-ray pictures of individual asbestos textile workers who are old timers as regards exposure to asbestos and whose current x-ray is either negative or only slightly positive.

Work history of the individual should accompany each set of pictures. The work history should include the length of exposure, the type of exposure, etc. Weight histories are not necessary.

If any of the employees were at any time removed from exposure, please give the removal dates as this may be a help in the problem of determining whether asbestosis progresses after the exposure to the asbestos ceases.

I understand that you will ask Mr. Hayes and Dr. Cowen to review the work histories and x-rays of both present and past employees at the Cicero Plant with the above in mind.

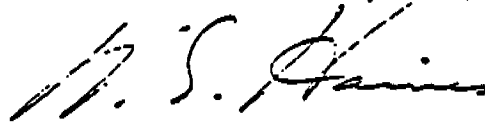
