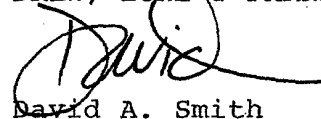

I have just received Judge Speed's Award dated July 24, 1986. As I had feared, Judge Speed found that stroke of December 6, 1985 is compensable under the Georgia Workers' Compensation Act. Specifically, Judge Speed found that exertion in the course of his work duties aggravated the claimant's pre-existing condition and, as such, is compensable under the Georgia case law.

I would recommend that we appeal this decision to the Full Board. While appeals to the Full Board seldomly result in a reversal, this action may put us in a better posture for settlement.
