Dear Mr. Edwards:

The error in your report that the four claims which I have not included in the article written for the August issue of THE HANDED were in fact at the plant where there would be little or no glass industry.

Actually, these men were doing the following work:

- 2 Machine Tenders
- 1 Laborer in the cullet grinding department
- 1 Glass and label painter

I could see no connection between the illnesses these men had and the glass manufacturing process. In fact, I do know that these men had worked in glass till plants prior to employment in the glass plant.

The report which you are indicating eight claims having been allowed is based on a basis that a claim which is allowed in an industry is caused by the industry.

When I write articles, I try to analyze each and every claim that is referred to the industry to determine whether it was actually caused by that industry.

I hope this takes care of your thought in connection with the discrepancy which appeared.
