Inmates in tanks 1 and 2 of from next door to clear the Ventura County Jail facility in Oxnard spent a chillier than usual night Sunday after sheriff's deputies removed all flammable materials from two cells at the jail.

The removal order came after inmates set fire to papers and bedding articles on two separate occasions in the evening, a sheriff's office spokesman said.

Shortly after midnight, a trustee helping deputies clean up disappeared into the darkness and escaped. Reported-escaped is Castor Rodriguez, of Oxnard, who was in custody on a failure to appear citation, the spokesman said.

The troubles began at 9:30 p.m. in tank 1 when inmates there set fire to papers on the catwalk, the spokesman said. The fires were put out and the inmates returned to their cells, but at 11:15 p.m. inmates in tank 2 followed suit setting fire to papers, mattresses and bedding, he said.

At the same time inmates in tank 1 smashed lightbulbs and toilets, he said.

Sheriff's deputies from the main jail in Ventura were dispatched to bring the situation under control by midnight. No injuries were reported and damage was confined to heavy smoke that filled the tanks.
