Gentlemen:

On October 24, 1957, we received a letter from the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare, Food and Drug Administration, in reply to our inquiry regarding the suitability of our "Bakelite" VCA-3420 for food packaging purposes. In answer the Food and Drug Administration stated in part:

"Comments from that Division (Division of Pharmacology) are as follows: VCA-3420 (Calendered Rigid Vinyl) and ... are acceptable for food packaging applications."

No specific request regarding suitability for milk or milk products was made at the time of inquiry or since. No limitation on use was indicated by the Food and Drug Administration.

We trust this supplies the necessary information.
