This will acknowledge your letter of March 7th addressed to this office with a copy of your letter under the same date to the Sankey Fuel & Transfer Company, Watertown, South Dakota.

The last paragraph of your letter to Mr. Sankey is in entire agreement with our thoughts on the matter, i.e., that no one has yet been known to have suffered lead poisoning from a spill of gasoline on the body. However, in view of the fact Mr. Sankey has consulted several doctors and that one of them stated he had lead poisoning, we feel it advisable to refer it to our Medical Department. It may be they will desire the name of the second doctor he who told Mr. Sankey he had lead poisoning.

In any case, you may rest assured our Medical Department will take care of it in a manner which, in their judgment, is adequate.
