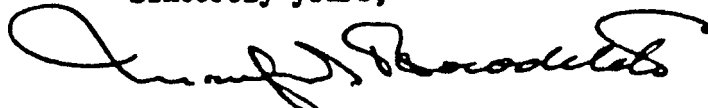

Dear Mr. Brown:

Thank you for your letter of March 21st. Though the points which I made in mine of the 18th with reference to Dr. Gardner's notes were spoken of as quotations, this was perhaps not the happiest choice of words, since I revised the phraseology in some instances for the sake of brevity. However, the sense of his notes was in no way altered.

The points with regard to lung cancer in experimental animals, to which you refer, were taken from page 8 of an "Outline of Proposed Monograph on Asbestosis" dated February, 1943, which was forwarded to you by Dr. Gardner on February 24, 1943, and acknowledged by you on March 1, 1943, with the comment that photostats were being made for distribution to the several interested companies. I trust that this identification will enable you to locate these papers. If not, we will of course be glad to provide whatever transcript you may wish.
