II. Achievements:

Considerable improvement was made in the health facilities in this yard, including a well-equipped ambulance. Preplacement examinations were made on all new employees.

III. Failures:

No periodics were done on crane operators. Basophilic aggregation tests were done on welders and painters and all were found negative.

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A contemplated chest x-ray survey by the Louisiana State Health Department was turned down due to the "fact that such x-rays might disclose conditions which might involve the company financially."
