- Summary of Findings -

I. ASBESTOSIS

1920 to 1940	92	50%
1940 to 1945	117	33%
1946 to 1951	61	26%
1951 to 1955	69	9%

II. LUNG CANCER

Mortality from lung cancer among workers exposed to asbestos dust is eight times greater than in the general population.

III. ENVIRONMENTAL EXPOSURE TO ASBESTOS

The time weighted exposure to asbestos rarely exceeded the Threshold Limit Value of 5 million particles per cubic foot or the British Upper Limit for safety value of 10 fibers per cubic centimeter.
