SUBJECT: Group Grievance Pittsburgh Corning Corporation, Tyler, Texas DATE December 18, 1968

On December 4, 1968 in a grievance meeting with Pittsburgh Corning Corp. Vice President C. L. Kelly, the Company agreed in settlement of a Group Grievance filed by the Workmen's Committee, to reimburse two employees who had been required to pay a \$25.00 deposit upon admission to the hospital. The Company also agreed to in the future until the present deductible plan can be changed to apply to the Medical Part of the Insurance Coverage. This is in accord with the present contract that no changes were to be made in the deductible plan.

Three copies of the letter from Company dated December 4, 1968 are attached.

The Local Workmen's Committee had not written you for the assistance of the International Union, but since I was in a meeting with the Company on two other grievances and this one was pending and was settled in the same meeting, I am furnishing your office with this information.
