SUBJECT: DATING SCHEDULE AND PACKAGE MARKING POLICY
FOR
CONSUMER DIVISION COATINGS MANUFACTURING FACILITIES

The attached Bulletin #5 Addendum 23 has been completely revised to present the proper forms for labeling and identifying containers and cartons as of the date of issue.

The major changes to the previous bulletin are:

1. Elimination of Heavy Metal/Lead Filling Suffices since they are no longer necessary.
2. Elimination of Rule 66 Identification since this is now indicated on all labels.
3. Elimination of the asterisk indicating a refill, and standardizing on an "RX" suffix for all repackaging and refilling.
4. Inclusion of the 1982 Dating Schedule.
5. Deletion of obsolete Factory codes and Addition of codes for Baltimore (D) and Los Angeles (Z).

DATING SCHEDULE AND PACKAGE MARKING POLICY FOR CONSUMER DIVISION COATINGS
MANUFACTURING FACILITIES

Policy

All containers shall be identified with the product number, the date code of production and the batch number prior to placement into distribution channels.

All cartons shall be identified with the product number and the date code of production prior to placement into distribution channels.

Procedure

1. All containers (ones and smaller) must be marked on the lid with the batch slip number and the filling date.
2. Five gallon containers require the Product No. along with the filling date stenciled in the upper rim. It is preferred procedure to stencil the Batch Slip No. conspicuously on the container, however, it is not mandatory at this time.
3. The batch number (Batch Slip) must be preceded by "BA".
4. The filling date must be prefixed by the Factory Code.
