Today on Climate Beat . . .

. . . we faced a logjam, reporting that Democratic plans to block Senate votes on several controversial Trump administration nominees for EPA slots are spurring some Republicans to retaliate with their own procedural holds, ensnaring multiple nominations for various energy and environment-related agencies.

In oil news, a coalition of 10 large international oil and gas companies formed to develop an industry response to climate change is announcing its first investments in low-carbon technology, with funds slated to go toward a low-emission cement production company, efficient vehicle engines and a natural gas with carbon capture project.

We highlighted some of this week's top stories, including news about EPA's GHG endangerment finding, environmentalists' pressure campaign on vehicle GHG rules, Trump's nomination battles and more.

And our daily news roundup looked at a new \$10 billion annual cost estimate for the Energy Department's coal and nuclear tariff plan, as well as oil sector and offshore wind updates.
