Air drying of 306L Lucite® acrylic lacquer results in a film containing about 20% carbon black, 40% polymethyl methacrylate resin, 10% polyester resin, and 30% cellulose acetate butyrate. The amount of residual solvent is unknown but would probably be quite small. The principle solvents used are aromatic hydrocarbons.
