As previously reported, Ford was to run a trial of a nonasbestos premix. This trial has been run and is considered successful. This means that Ford now has an alternative method of producing their premix, and that if the Federal Regulations create an undue burden or dust levels remain uncontrollable that Ford can now switch because "Ford has a better idea".

The nonasbestos material was Woll-stonite, from Interpace Co. George estimated that their production (Interpace) was to go from 50,000 ton/year to 100,000 ton/year next year.
