

yard of a home made attractive as the front garden was emphasized by Howard Gilkey, Oakland's landscape engineer, in speaking before the Home Forum of the Oakland Y. M. C. A. recently. Gilkey talked particularly to the landscape design as applied to the small city lot. He said:

"Front yard planting should consist mainly of low evergreen shrubs placed at the base of the house to soften the transition from formal architectural lines to the soft undulations of nature. Long-lived flowering plants should be placed judiciously in nooks in the shrubbery, but not provide the principal effect in this region where, unlike the cold East, the bare ground left by perennials is not concealed beneath a mantle of snow when the herbaceous plants have died down.

"Between the base planting and the sidewalk there should be an unobstructed lawn. Fortunately we are well divorced from the mid-Victorian custom of filling every open space with some fiendishly conceived 'star,' 'crescent,' or 'circular' design, jammed full of unhappy short-lived plants.

"The rear garden should be attractive and developed to secure privacy. The garden should be made attractive not only with beautiful flowering shrubs, but may well reveal enhanced attractiveness in the form of lovely berries or shapely branches, or reveal new charm in luscious autumn tints or rosy new leaf growth, but also the garden should be the sanctuary for some lovely piece of garden sculpture, fount, or sun dial.

"Appropriately enough, an outdoor fireplace, perhaps rustic, or in the form of a formal Greek altar piece might be the centralizing motif to make the garden attractive even in the cool evenings."
