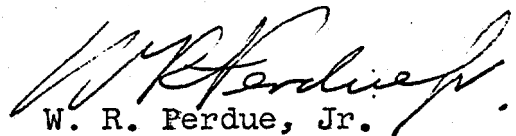

FOR USE AS A

CONTAINS
L E A D
(ANTIKNOCK COMPOUNDS)

I understand that you have received
from others a proposal omitting the parenthesis.
This will advise you that we have no objection
to this change.

Since it will be necessary for us to
order a new supply of lead warning signs
within the next sixty days, I would appreciate
it very much if you would proceed with clearing
this form with the Office of the Surgeon
General.
