One excellent vehicle for your purpose is Texas Instruments, a blue chip growth issue and the leading manufacturer of semiconductor products. Earnings are somewhat cyclical but in a generally rising trend.

Another selection, Greyhound Corp., controls the world's largest bus system. Diversification in recent years resulted in the company setting up a subsidiary in computer leasing which is 78 per cent owned. Another wholly owned subsidiary leases industrial machinery and office equipment. Recent acquisitions have moved Greyhound into the food and office service fields.

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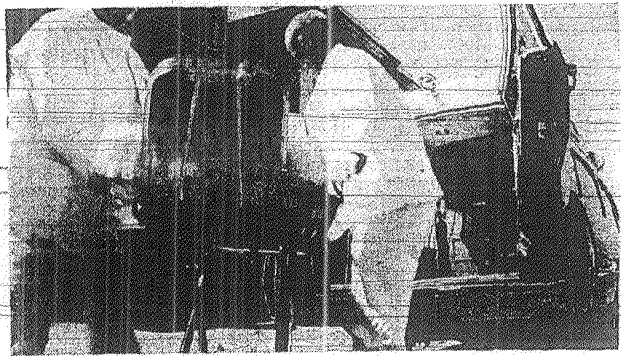
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Market for New Shopping Center

This Purity Market is to be the key facility in the new Montgrove Shopping Center at Lighthouse and David avenues. The shopping center derived its name from the fact that it is partially in Monterey and partially in Pacific Grove. It is owned by members of the Work family (T. A. Work Jr., Frank Work, Stuart Work and Mrs. Elizabeth Kirby) and the T. A. Work estate. It is located on the former Work Lumber Co. site. Construction on the market structure will start in one month and will be completed approximately seven months later. The 23,000-square-foot building will cost an estimated \$349,000, including site work. Architect is William D. Concolino. Eventually, the shopping center will contain 63,000 square feet of buildings.

State Bills Affecting Motorists Reviewed

SACRAMENTO — Assemblyman Alan G. Pattee, R-Corral de Tierra, in his weekly newsletter, has described three bills affecting automobile insurance premiums as a result of minor accidents and minor traffic violations. But on the other hand, rates for many companies will go up 3.2 per cent.

One, he said, bars an insurance company from canceling a policy during its terms—unless the insured failed to pay his premium or has his driver's license or motor vehicle registration taken away.

Another requires a company to explain in writing why it is refusing to renew a policy.

A third purges the Department of Motor Vehicles' files of reports on accident in which the motorist was not at fault.

Adult School To Begin

Classes in stenograph, home repair, tailoring and drawing and painting open tonight in the Peninsula Unified School District's adult school. A wide variety of vocational courses start tomorrow.

Stenograph, described as a quick and easy method of writing shorthand, will be taught by Mrs. Ester Miller at Seaside High School Tuesdays and Thursdays from 7 to 9:30 p.m.

Tailoring classes in tailoring are scheduled Tuesdays and Thursdays, Monterey High School. Drawing and painting for adults will be taught evenings at Seaside High School and Los Arboles Junior High School in Marina, Tuesdays and Thursdays from 7 to 9:30 p.m.

A number of 10-week vocational courses also are being scheduled at night to provide immediate training for unemployed and underemployed adults. These include:

Light equipment operator, house maintenance repairman, sales clerk, service station management, automotive brake and front-end alignment, basic and advanced typing, automotive tune-up repair and lathe operation.

20-week Courses Twenty-week courses are offered in radio and television repair, practical nursing, shorthand, welding, tailoring, office machine operator, custodial training, woodworking and refinishing, and bookkeeping. The vocational courses start tomorrow. Further information on these may be obtained by calling the adult school principal at 372-7111.

Information on other adult school classes may be obtained by calling 372-0320 between 6 and 10 p.m. or 394-3983 between 6:30 and 9:30 p.m.

P.G. Classes

The Pacific Grove Adult School will offer a variety of classes when it opens its doors tonight for the first evening of classes in the fall semester.

According to Leith Heyl, principal of the adult school evening division, classes in subjects ranging from tailoring to home maintenance are included in the curriculum.

The first class in home maintenance will be held tomorrow night from 7 to 10 p.m. The first class in clothing and tailoring begins at 7 o'clock this evening and ends at 10 o'clock.

Beginning tomorrow evening, a class designed to help prepare teacher's aides for voluntary or paid employment will be offered, and a class in English as a second language will also be offered, from 7 to 9:30 p.m.

Another course beginning this evening is automotive mechanics. The class will be held every Tuesday evening from 7 to 10 p.m. in the high school auto-body shop.

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
