Personnel dosimeter monitoring testing conducted again on December 10, 1979 indicate you were exposed to a vinyl chloride concentration of 0.005 ppm measured over an 8.0-hour period. In accordance with OSHA Standard for VCM Exposure, Title 29, Chapter XVII, Part 1910.93(q) an exposure above 0.5 ppm of VCM requires that I offer to you an opportunity for medical surveillance at the company's expense if you desire such action.

Medical surveillance will consist of a blood testing procedure and a hands on physical examination by a doctor assigned by the company. Results of these examinations will be made available to you or your designee upon your written request and signature of release on the prescribed form. The time spent for blood testing and doctor's examination will not be paid for by the company.
