

Day of Red Chief Foster

LONDON April 13. (AP)—An American Communist leader denounced Gen Dwight D. Eisenhower today as "a reactionary, a jingo-militarist and an aggressive imperialist."

William Z. Foster, chairman of the U.S. Communist Party and the party's presidential candidate in 1924, 1928 and 1932, made the denunciation in a message to the 22nd National Congress of the British Communist Party.

More than 900 delegates and

others present cheered the attack on Eisenhower, who is leaving his job as supreme commander of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization forces soon to return home where he is being boomed for the Republican presidential nomination.

Foster said Eisenhower is "the outstanding figure in the presidential race and 'has a huge mass following, including large numbers of workers."

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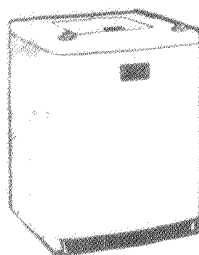
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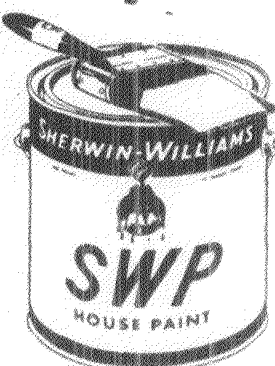
