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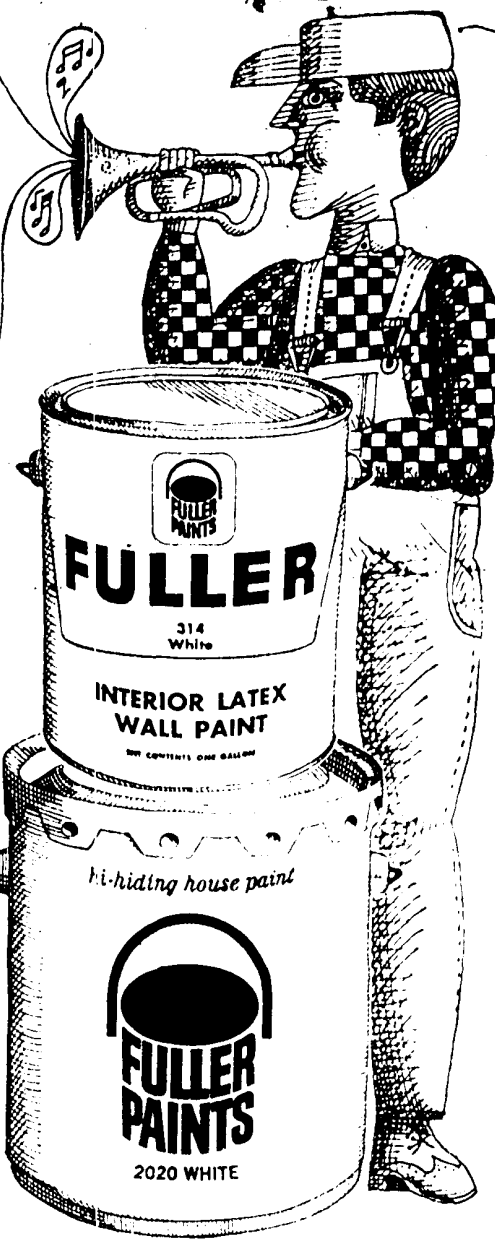

Vietnam demilitarized zone and assaulted and captured a hilltop fortress that had been tormenting them with rocket and mortar fire. American spokesmen said early today.

More than 300 Marines threw back North Vietnamese attacks below the zone Thursday and then roared into the neutral zone and up the bunker-infested slope of Hill 117.

Six hours later — at the cost of about 14 Marines and 84 North Vietnamese lives — the Leathernecks had conquered the hill.

A multi-battalion force of Marines of the fourth and sixth Regiments seized the hill which lies five miles to the northwest of the Marine border post at Con Thien.

Several Marine units had come under rocket and mortar fire just south of the buffer zone yesterday from communist gun positions in the zone. Four Marines were killed and 17 wounded.

This morning a U.S. military spokesman also disclosed

were no casualties and damage to the ship was slight, it was reported.

After receiving the hit, the cruiser lashed out with her big guns and silenced a North Vietnamese artillery battery, located about 12 miles northeast of Gio Linh.

Over the North, pilots from the carrier Bon Homme Richard hit the Kien An airfield five miles southwest of Haiphong. Their bombs were reported "on target" but there was no assessment of damage to the airfield.

Hanoi radio claimed that four U.S. planes were shot down Thursday, two over Haiphong. There was no confirmation from Saigon.

Pilots from the nuclear carrier Enterprise struck a railroad complex 34 miles north-northwest of Thanh Hoa Thursday.

A U.S. Air Force raid over North Vietnam focused on three main rail yards North-east of Hanoi, at Kep, Vu Chua and Bac Le about 50 miles from the capital.

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
