Gentlemen:

Enclosed are:

- (1) UL Report R4359-37, dated November 16, 1972 "Acceptability of Type MK5 Comenititious Mixture in Existing Fire Resistance Ratings" and
- (2) October 1972 Bulletin "Zenolite Announces MONOKOTE 5, The Improved Asbestos-Free Plaster-Type Fireproofing Material" along with draft of cover letter (dated October 22, 1972) accompanying the Bulletin.

The UL Report "approves" MK5 for every UL design now presently approved with MK3 - except for those variations of tested assemblies as noted on the bottom of page T1-5 (assemblies utilizing steel floor units where MK3 is approved in combinations of fluted and cellular deck in which the ratio of cellular to fluted sections exceeds 50 percent).

The MK5 announcement has been made in the Eastern and Mid-West Regions only - where asbestos containing fireproofing materials have already been banned. There is at this time no schedule set for introducing MK5 into any other area until we have completed all field testing and/or EPA action.
