On May 27, 2021, XTO Energy Inc. ("XTO") entered into an Administrative Compliance Order on Consent ("AOC"), Docket No. CAA-06-2021-3324, with the United States Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") to resolve certain alleged violations of the New Mexico Administrative Code, which had been adopted into the New Mexico State Implementation Plan. Pursuant to the AOC, XTO agreed to specific requirements as outlined in paragraph 27 to be completed within six months of the AOC Effective Date (i.e., no later than November 23, 2021).

EPA has received and reviewed your August 25, 2021 final letter report, required under AOC paragraph 27, of all work completed under the AOC. Upon review, EPA hereby confirms that you have completed all requirements under the AOC satisfactorily.
