Report of State Initiatives for Asbestos  
Regulation as of December 1, 1977

Since passage of the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 (OSH Act) and the Clean Air Act of 1970 with their implementing Occupational Exposure to Asbestos Standard and National Emissions Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAPS), respectively, several states have exercised their prerogative to develop legislation and regulations regarding the use of asbestos.

Under the OSH Act, states may develop and conduct occupational safety and health regulatory programs. A state plan must be submitted to and approved by federal OSHA in order to have power of enforcement. If the plan is approved, both the state and federal government exercise authority over the plan. The plan is certified when federal OSHA determines that the state is competent to enforce its plan, which must be at least as effective as or identical to federal regulations. The state is then responsible for implementing and enforcing occupational safety and health activities. Certified state plans are subject to federal OSHA evaluation semi-annually. Due to the failure of state legislatures to pass enabling legislation or because a state may have decided the costs involved in implementation were not acceptable, some states have withdrawn their proposed plans, thus returning to federal jurisdiction for occupational safety and health matters.

Attachment I identifies the status of each state's occupational safety and health and air pollution program. Attachment II summarizes state and certain municipal actions and/or proposed actions with regard to use of asbestos. An asterisk (\*) is used to indicate that additional information is provided in Attachment II.

Documents cited in this report are on file in the AIA/NA office and are available on request.

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While a concerted effort has been made to provide as complete information as possible in this report, it is acknowledged that omissions may exist. Information now known or that which may become known, pertinent to this report, is solicited. It is planned to update this report when and as appropriate.

EXPLANATORY NOTE:

Many states are divided into air quality control districts for enforcement NESHAPS and report directly to the federal EPA. Some state districts, counties and cities have developed and enforce their own regulations.

CALIFORNIA     - All districts have adopted NESHAPS asbestos provisions. Del Nora, Humboldt, Kern, Mendocino, N. Sonora, Trinity and San Diego districts have plans. Other districts fall under state provisions as regards waste disposal.

NEVADA       - Washoe district has plan.

TENNESSEE    - Nashville and Knoxville districts have plans.

ILLINOIS     - Chicago has plan. Cook County is developing plan.

MASSACHUSETTS - Boston has plan.

NEW YORK     - New York City has plan.

PENNSYLVANIA - Philadelphia has plan.

CALIFORNIA

ATTACHMENT II

- Chap. 1432 prohibits any person from causing or permitting the spraying of any substance containing asbestos in or upon a building, or other structure during its construction, alteration or repair.

S.B.176. Enacted 1977. Makes it illegal for authorities to issue building permits which would authorize illegal building practices such as spraying of certain asbestos-containing materials.

S.B.230. Enacted 1977. Requires that the asbestos spraying prohibition be enforced by the Department of Health for the environmental aspects and Cal/OSHA for occupational aspects.

S.B.1678. Enacted 1976. Requires the regulation of carcinogens of which asbestos reporting regulations must be promulgated.

\$5208 Cal/OSHA. Enacted May 26, 1977, effective September 1, 1977. Employers must register with Division of Industrial Safety if any use, handling, disposal, processing, manufacturing, packaging or repackaging of asbestos or asbestos-containing products which require labeling, brake repair and clutch repair operations where asbestos materials used.

Proposed regulations for hazardous and extremely hazardous waste may require that:

- asbestos must be transported in sealed containers and wetted or transported in closed vehicles, if wastes are bulky
- warning label must be attached to all containers
- waste must be accompanied by a properly completed California Waste Hauler Record
- fee for hazardous waste disposal - \$1/ton
- industries which dispose of hazardous waste on own property submit monthly reports

CONNECTICUT

- P.L. 77-445. Effective 10/1/72. Requires employers to provide lung function tests. Employees may refuse.
- P.L. 77-107. Effective 10/1/77. Upon written request an employer shall furnish employee with list of hazardous substances used in workplace.
- P.L. 77-398. Effective 10/1/77. Regulation of Carcinogenic Substances: (first regulation proposed 11/23/77)
  - \$1 - defines asbestos as carcinogenic
  - \$2 - anyone who uses or produces a carcinogenic substance shall report by January 1 of each year:

- (1) method of disposal
- (2) amount used or produced that year
- (3) amount currently held in inventory
- (4) method used to transport carcinogenic substance

Proposed ambient air quality standard of 30 nanograms/cubic meter pending.

ILLINOIS

- In 1972, prohibited spraying of asbestos-containing material.
- Under waste disposal provisions asbestos shall be wetted and placed in tightly sealed container and buried.
- Cook County proposal would require permit for hazardous waste disposal and charge to employer.

SL239. Enacted August 26, 1977. Requires transportation of hazardous materials within state to follow regulations of U.S. Department of Transportation.

IOWA

- H.439 a solid waste disposal bill and H.520, handling of hazardous waste, will be carried over to the 1978 legislative session.

KANSAS

- H.1715. Effective 1974. Relates to Workmen's Compensation providing for liability of employers for certain injuries and occupational diseases including asbestosis and silicosis.

MARYLAND

- S-807. Effective July 1, 1977. Article 43, Section 33: Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene must adopt procedures to secure information about incidence and cause of diseases caused by toxic and carcinogenic substances.

MICHIGAN

- S-63 - toxic substances control bill which has passed the Michigan Senate. House working on similar proposal. Bill authorizes State the power to adopt measures of control in emergency situations dealing with carcinogenic substances.

MINNESOTA

- Effective December 1974, §325.244 of Minnesota Statutes bans use and shipment of powdered asbestos.

C-1788 - pending - prohibits transportation of hazardous waste into Minnesota for disposal.

Regulations on hazardous waste management and disposal expected after January 1978.

MISSOURI

- 1977 enacted Hazardous Waste Disposal law. Regulations to be promulgated.

MONTANA

- 1977 enacted Hazardous Waste Disposal Act. Currently in process of holding hearings on regulations. Asbestos is classified as a Class I waste and can only be discharged into a Class I site (most extensively regulated dumping site).

NEW JERSEY

- Effective August 15, 1977, spray-on friable asbestos banned where greater than 0.25% by weight.

S-3035 - pending - Cancer Control Act empowers Department of Environmental Control to adopt rules and regulations to condition and control carcinogenic emissions and the production, use, sale and labeling of products containing carcinogens.

A-3009 - pending - prohibits presence or use of asbestos within schools or dwellings.

N.J.A.C.7:26-1 - When disposing of asbestos waste, report must be submitted by each generator to Bureau of Hazardous and Chemical Wastes prior to disposal indicating quantities of asbestos material, hauler identification and landfill site.

NEW YORK

- N.Y. Statute 325.244 bans powdered asbestos if dust will emanate due to handling, mixing or cutting for purposes of construction or improving any structure.

Chap. 577 - Amends Workmen's Compensation law to include partial disability resulting from silicosis or other dust diseases.

A-3562 - pending - gives state power to control transfer and storage of hazardous substances.

A-7242 - pending - prohibits use of asbestos or fibrous glass as lining in interior of air duct systems.

- N. CAROLINA
  - Chap. 1061. Provides medical expenses in asbestosis and silicosis cases under Workmen's Compensation Act.
- VIRGINIA
  - Chap. 28 1976 enacted Toxic Substances Information Act. Regulations being developed.
- WASHINGTON
  - Washington Department of Labor has stated medical examinations will be required when employee is exposed to 0.1 fibers/cc greater than 5 microns in length.
- WISCONSIN
  - July 1977. Enacted hazardous waste management program. Regulations yet to be promulgated.
