Comment:

The North Slope energy assessments currently being contemplated as part of Secretary Zinke's Secretarial Order 3352 would be standard energy resource assessments that would estimate the undiscovered technically recoverable resources available in particular tracts of land. Such assessments do not integrate biological or land use data from USGS or other sources. The Energy Resources Program has piloted multi-resource analysis of the Piceance and Powder River basins, both energy producing areas, that did include such integrated data. Energy and Minerals has, and is, proposing similar multi-resource analysis for assessments to other DOI bureaus; they could become a paradigm for integrated USGS science in the future.
