NEW YORK, JULY 27, 1967 - John B. Henrich has been elected executive vice president and general counsel of National Lead Company, it was announced today by Joseph A. Martino, chairman of the board. Mr. Henrich began his company career in 1935 as a member of the patent department. He was named assistant secretary of the company in 1943 and secretary in 1948. He is chairman of National Lead Company's pension and life insurance board, and of the administrative committee of the employees' profit-sharing plan.
