This has reference to our letters of July 30 and 31st and your letters of August 12 and 19th to Riley Stoker Corporation concerning an extra for their erecting the Forced Draft Fan Motor and Turbine, Induced Draft Fan and Turbine together with the Hawick Clutch Type Couplings and also the Motors for the Pulverizer.

In accordance with our telephone conversation, I have discussed with Mr. A. G. Heins Riley's reply of August 25, 1953 in which they quote a price of \$3,222.00 for furnishing erection labor for this work. This price meets with our approval and, therefore, will be in order for you to issue an amendment to Riley for this addition.
