Rex R. Lloyd has been named plant manager at the Henderson, Nevada, plant of Titanium Metals Corporation of America. Mr. Lloyd joined TMCA at Henderson in 1954 as process superintendent. Previously, he had been in charge of the U. S. Bureau of Mines experimental station at Boulder City, Nevada, where the Kroll method for the manufacture of titanium metal was adapted to commercial production.
