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Dear Dr. McCormick:

In accordance with your request of April 10 we are repeating a statement regarding the acceptability of Geon Resin 500X749 as a component of plastic film used for packaging products prepared under Federal meat inspection because of an error in our letter of April 4.

On the basis of your assurance that Geon Resin 500X749 is composed of polyvinyl chloride and Hycar rubber to which has been added approximately 1% of Santomerse S, plastic film containing the resin, if otherwise satisfactory, is acceptable to this Division for packaging meat and meat food product.
