Dave Slota is directly assigned the responsibility of complying with all the reports and analyses required under the General Tire Permit No. OH 070 OX2 2 000109.

Roy George is responsible for controlling the process to meet the requirements spelled out in the permit as effluent limitations.

Roy George and Dave Slota should constantly communicate and assist each other in completing their responsibilities.

Dave Slota will be responsible for assuring that the analyses are completed by the prescribed methods of the Federal EPA. These procedures will be run as outlined in the memo from Roy Jackson to Harlan Jewett* outlining on a mimeographed sheet the appropriate test procedure for each test item. A formal procedure for MVC in water should be written and submitted to State EPA.

① Completion of final plans will have to be submitted by May 1, 1974. This will be Roy George's responsibility.

② Commencement of construction delineated in the final plans will have to start by July 1, 1974.

Completion of construction and/or modifications will have to be completed by December 1, 1974.

In the permit General Tire is committed to Option A.

Roy George will be responsible for giving the monitored data to Dave Slota before each reporting date and develop a water incoming flow rate versus discharge rate for March, April and May so we can request a change to reporting incoming flow rates.

Roy Parker is responsible for ensuring operation of waste treatment system in compliance with established engineering procedures.

+ Roy George and the writer will be responsible for writing the Spill Prevention Control Procedure which is past due already.
