missed a narcotics charge against Coogan on grounds of insufficient evidence. Arresting officers had reported finding marijuana at Coogan's Malibu home.

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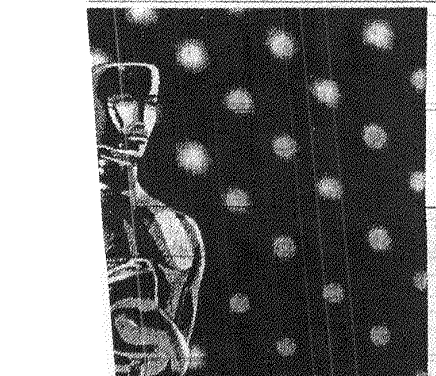
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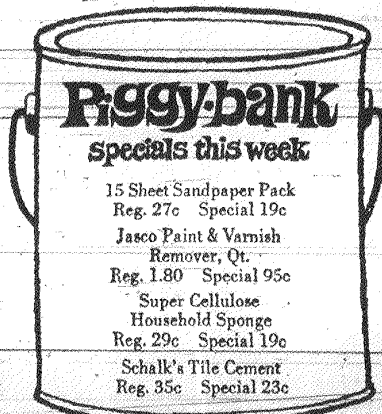

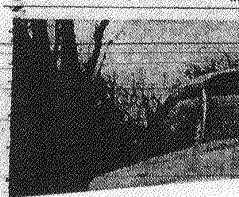
Wives Group To See Film About Navy
