been in existence for twenty (20) or more years.

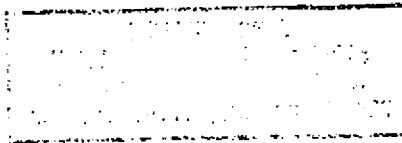
