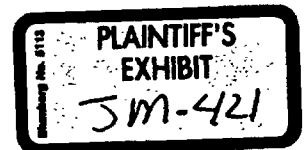
In as much as I have been informed that the company is liable, may I have your advice as to the proper procedure to take in filing a claim of this nature.
