Dear Mr. Regan:

As a regular service of our Loss Prevention Medical Department, I visited your plant on September 5, 1968 to review plant medical procedures in relation to the control of Workmen's Compensation losses.

I regret that I was unable to meet with you on that initial visit. However, Mr. Popkin was most helpful in his review of your current Physical Examination Program and the emergency handling of work injuries. At this time we also discussed a medical survey of Workmen's Compensation claims which were reported during the current and previous policy years. Of the eleven cases reported for this year, several involved new employees. However, there was no evidence of improper placement or aggravation of a pre existing condition. It was further noted that 80% of the cases were treated and followed up by your designated plant physician, which is an indication of excellent case control. As the result of this discussion and my observations, the following suggestions were offered for the improvement of the existing programs:

1. Return to Work Procedures
2. Trained First Aiders
3. First Aid Record
