Gentlemen:-

STANDARD ZINC:

We acknowledge receipt of your night letter message of the 21st inst., instructing us to place contract with New Jersey Zinc Co. for 150 tons Standard Zinc 5% Lead, shipping 50 tons each month; also note you would like first shipment immediately.

We took up this matter with the New Jersey Zinc Co., and they advise that the best they can do would be to let us have 20 tons of the Standard Zinc at once, at contract price, but cannot apply same on contract.

If you wish the 20 tons shipped at once, they will make contract with us for 130 tons to be shipped in equal quantities during the third quarter, or will contract for 150 tons to be shipped in 50 ton lots, first shipment to go forward in July.

We confirm our night letter message of even date giving you the above information and now await your reply.
