We have been missing each other and I thought that I would write to you concerning the nature of my calls.

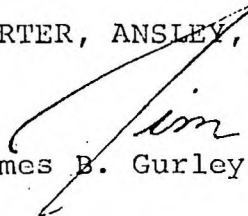
