I have sent, under separate cover, your pipe. It should arrive shortly. It was parked by the cock-tail shaker. I am also forwarding, under separate cover, the papers you left here together with a list of the men in our regular excretion group showing the length of service in the Tetra Ethyl Lead area. You will note on several that there are a series of dates. These dates indicate the periods of time spent in the Lead area.

We are also giving you a memorandum on the production from 1926 to date. This is expressed in millions of pounds. In other words, .7 represents 700,000 pounds.. Note there is a correlation between production and the symptoms we have seen on the charts we examined.

While this is not entirely accurate it is apparent that with the increase in production there has been an increase in symptomatology.
