Just a quick note to say that I am in town and that Ryan and I talked this morning regarding the likely time of my coming into EPA and the remuneration for my efforts. I understand that the timing of the EPA employment depends primarily on the scheduling of the EPW hearings, which are not likely to happen much before mid September, after the congressional recess. So, I will let my university folks know that they have me for the balance of August and perhaps a week or

two in September. Please let me know if this changes, or if you need me to come in earlier. At this point, the university is giving me the month of August off to prepare for my hearings, so EPA does not have to worry about any kind of payment for this effort.

As you may also already know (since my university is a public organization), my salary approximates a executive level III or about 170K per year. I am expecting at least this amount plus moving expenses to work in DC. However, I am also willing to consider an executive level I or perhaps level II position without moving expenses. And of course, I am more than happy to talk with you about other options.
