AP AND LATERAL CHEST DATED 06/18/03:

HISTORY: ATRIAL FIBRILLATION, POST PACEMAKER.

COMPARISON: No comparisons are available.

FINDINGS: A single pacemaker electrode is positioned at the right ventricular apex. The cable is intact leading to the pulse generator in the anterior upper left chest.

The heart size is normal. Mild aortic arch calcification and tortuosity indicate atherosclerosis.

Aside from minimal linear atelectasis at the left lung base, lungs are clear. No lung edema. The main pulmonary artery is mildly prominent which could reflect pulmonary arterial hypertension.

IMPRESSION:

1. Pacemaker electrode at right ventricular apex.
2. Mild left lower lobe atelectasis.
3. Prominent main pulmonary artery which may reflect pulmonary arterial hypertension.
