

church in the United States; and the hosts of the audience at the Mt. St. Alban National Cathedral included 125 bishops from nations all over the world, 800 clericals and lay deputies and 500 delegates from the Woman's Auxiliary.

Bishop Anderson derided the controversy between fundamentalism and modernism, "defended science, attacked secularism in every guise and declared the doctrine of a new church in a free state" to be necessary to the well-being of both church and state. In closing, he took his own church to task for not meeting current problems.

Describing achievements of science and invention as "the crowning glory" of the century, Bishop Anderson said it "is not in the interest of religion to go out of the way to pick quarrels with science or to belittle demonstrated facts."

He defined the function of religion as "to interpret these facts in terms of spiritual value."

**SAN FRANCISCO, Oct. 10 (AP)**—General price recovery marked by moderate trading characterized the market on the San Francisco Stock Exchange this morning. Kolster opening at 72 1/2, climbed to 73 1/2. Illinois Pacific Glass opened at 52 1/2, climbing up to 54 1/2, before yielding a point. Caterpillar opened at 81 1/2, then softened before climbing to 83 1/2. Byron Jackson starting at 100 1/2, climbed to 100 1/2, then fell a fraction. Atlas Diesel held at 78. Crown-Zellerbach certificates sold at 24 1/2. Golden State Milk opened at 62 1/2, eased to 61 1/2, and came back to 62. Magnavox opened at 5 1/2, yielded a fraction and recovered to 5 1/2. California Ink opened to 62, then eased a half, but climbed to 62 1/2.

The banks were slightly higher. Bancitaly Corporation opened at 124 1/2 and sold to 125. Bank of Italy starting at 192 1/2 sold to 192 1/2. American Company sold at 151.
