Gentlemen:-

ZINC OXIDE:

We acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 15th inst., and note you are sending us orders for 50 tons Green Seal and 45 tons Red Seal Zinc, which you find will cover your requirements for the balance of the year 1920, and that we are to disregard figures recently sent us on these two grades. Also note that you will not need any Standard Zinc.

As mentioned in our letter of May 13th we placed order with the New Jersey Zinc Co. for 25 tons Red Seal and 40 tons Green Seal and on May 19th sent you contract covering the Green Seal.

On receipt of your letter mentioned above we again took up this matter with the New Jersey Co. and tried to get them to increase the amount of the Green Seal to 55 tons. They advise that it is utterly impossible for them to do so at the present time. They will bear us in mind and as soon as they have any Green Seal available will immediately notify us.

They will increase the Red Seal from 25 to 45 tons and expect to be able to ship this grade to the Pacific Mail Steamer at Baltimore within the next couple of weeks.
