To Members of the Lead Industries Association:

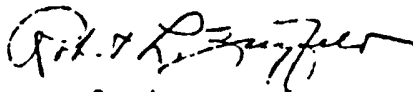
We are enclosing a photograph of an educational exhibit depicting the use of lead in various phases of the ceramic industries which we are offering as a permanent display to twenty (20) of the leading ceramic schools throughout the United States.

This exhibit measures approximately 5 ft. x 4 ft. x 1 ft. and is equipped with 24 in. high detachable legs so that it may be used either as a floor display or, with legs removed, hung on the wall.

Included in the display, in addition to photographs, are actual samples of the lead compounds in test tube bottles as well as actual samples of the ceramic products in which these lead compounds are used.

Our technical manual, "Lead in the Ceramic Industries," is also a part of the display and is being offered free to all ceramic students upon request.

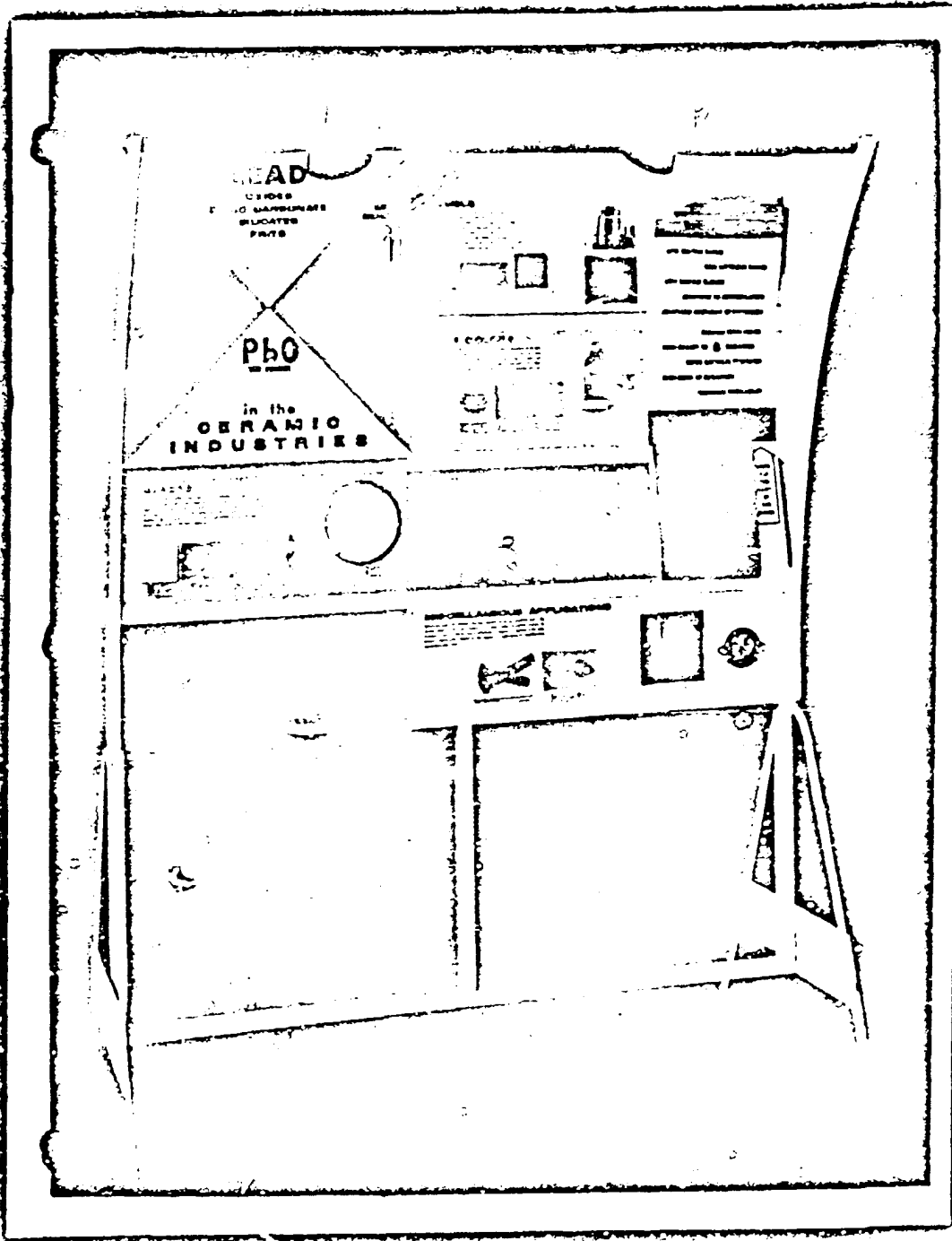
